# Public Hearing - Ordinance No. 2024-01

An overview of Ordinance No. 2024-01 – was introduced by the Mayor and Council at a Public Meeting held on January 17, 2024. Public Notice was posted on the Towns website and published in the Kent County News on January 25, 2024 and February 1, 2024 giving a fair summary of the ordinance and soliciting written comments concerning the same.

Mayor Cook read Ordinance No. 2024-01 – FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 102 (Fees) of the Code of the Town of Rock Hall to provide that an application for five or more water connections and/or five or more sewer connections shall be entitled to a discount of ten percent on the total amount of the connection charges, subject to certain conditions; providing that the title of this Ordinance shall be deemed a fair summary, and generally relating to municipal fees, rates, and charges of the Town of Rock Hall.
