1. Entries will be accepted starting September 15, 2018 through to October 20th, 2018. Entries may be submitted online, emailed, faxed, mailed, or delivered to Rock Hall Town Hall. P.O. BOX 367, 5585 South Main Street, Rock Hall, MD 21661.
2. Entrants must turn in a completed application form, even when submitting a video. Forms are available online at <http://www.rockhallmd.com/office-mayor> or by emailing Mayor Brian Jones brjones@rockhallmd.gov.
3. All applicants must have permission from a parent or legal guardian to participate.
4. Entries must represent an individual's idea. Ideas adapted from other communities are okay.
5. An entrant may submit only one idea per contest. (Save the others for another time!)
6. A preliminary review by Rock Hall staff and officials will be conducted to ensure application

completeness and to shortlist the entries for final judging.

7. The judging panel will consist Rock Hall citizens, members of town committees, officials and staff.

8. Final judging will occur the week of October 22 – 26, 2018.

9. The Judging panel will rate the entries on a scale of 1 through 10 in the following criteria:

- a) The originality of the idea
- b) The marketability and cost of the idea
- c) The ability of the Town to implement the idea
- d) The overall benefit of the idea to Rock Hall residents, citizens and visitors

10. One winner will be chosen to spend the day with Mayor Brian Jones on November 8th, 2018 from 11am – 3pm and invited to assist Mayor Jones at the Town Meeting at 7:30 PM.

11. Only the winner will be contacted. If you have not received a phone call by October 26th at 4pm, your application was not selected. Please know that your application and idea was greatly appreciated and we look forward to seeing your next submission in the future.

We appreciate all entries/ideas, however entries are considered conceptual and may or may not be implemented by the Town.
