b. #2 running with Pump #1-New Pump on order for #2 position – February 9th estimated delivery.

c. #3 - #1 pump running and #2 pump need valve repaired for pump removal.

Water Meter & Utility Billing Software Upgrade

MRDC assisting to determine how Town can use remaining project funding to complete installation of water meters. RFQ to install meters being prepared.

2017 USDA Water Improvement Project Finalization

Scheduling meeting with McCrone and USDA to finalize.

Kent Co Water/Sewer Agreement

Quoting installation cost for new meter (RFQ) - first quote \$87,000.00.

Will need to adjust ARPA funding to support project.

ENR Upgrade Project

Wastewater Treatment Plant

Design Schedule/ Milestone Dates

Nearing 50%, will meet with Town Ops at 60% to cover electrical/controls. Likely be end of January meeting.

February 2023 – 90% Design Complete / Initial Permit Submissions.

May 2023 – 100% Design Complete / Permits Acquired.

June 2023 – Bids advertised.

July 2023 – Bids opened

October 2023 - Construction NTP

Headworks Replacement – WWTP

Screen start up week of January 16, 2023.

Pump Stations Upgrade/Replacement

Added to MRDC Circuit Rider list.

Will complete application by end of January.

#1,2,3 Pump Station are priority (not all pump station).

MRDC Meeting

Suggest looking into funding for PER development that would cover entire sanitary sewer collection system so necessary improvements can be documented and prioritized.

Haven Road, ENR, Pump Station, Pump Station Distribution and Boundary Avenue.

Closing Trailer/Mower project with USDA.

Will review new funding from State related to delinquent utility payment (new Governor Hogan Announces \$20 Million Water Assistance Relief Program).
