Sale of Municipal Property

Appraisal company coming next week to appraise the building.

There are two Real Estate Agents that are interested in listing the building to sale.

Frank Hodgetts to review the building with his architect to see if they want to purchase the building.

Need to ask Legal the process of selling off Municipal property and buildings.

Relocation of Museum Artifacts

Museum Board will be going forward with the RFP for the relocation of the artifacts. New quote for moving the artifacts came in at \$31,500.00. A discussion followed.

Financial Planning Project

Need to work on a spreadsheet that shows all the projects and shows when the need for funds should start.

Old Business

<u>Airbnb's</u>

Expanding Economic Development and Tourism by focusing on short term rentals. Rental taxes and licenses are income for the Town. Need to look at the Counties list for registered Airbnb's in Rock Hall. Will need to talk to legal about the possibility of changing the ordinances for the short-term rentals, Airbnb and VRBO.

Civic Center Drainage Project

Mayor Jacobs stated that the Town should start working on starting a Special Committee to work in the Sea Level Rise.

Resignation Letter

Councilmember Collyer made a motion to accept Tot Strong's resignation letter to the Museum Board. Vice Mayor Jones seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

<u>Weather Issues</u>

Town Manager Resele talked about how to communicate better with residents when there is an emergency at their residence when they are not there. Like when pipes freeze and burst.

Town Manager Resele wants to start a program where all the houses in Rock Hall display their 911 address. He also would like to get information on EV charging stations and locations within the Town.

There was a conversation about moving the Town Hall Conversation Session from Sunday, January 8, 2023 to Sunday, January 22, 2023. Council agreed for the session to be moved.
